
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


Instead of displays of power, Jesus tells his disciples that service to one another is what shows that they are his followers.

Enrolling Your Child at St Joseph's School, Yarra Junction Term 4 update

St Joseph's Catholic Primary School has been established to serve the needs of children and their families in the Upper Yarra Valley. We strive to be open and welcoming to all students, regardless of their background and needs, and do everything possible to accommodate a student's individual needs. We welcome children of other Christian traditions and other faiths who seek what Catholic education has to offer.

Enrolment

All children enrolling at St Joseph's need to be 5 years of age by the 30th of April of the year they start school. Parents will need to complete an enrolment application for each child and submit it to the office along with the following documents:

- Original Birth Certificate
- Certificate of Immunisation (request a copy online from the Australian Childhood Immunisation Register (ACIR)
- Baptism Certificate (if applicable)

Enrolment Application

Download a St Joseph's Catholic Primary School Enrolment Application Form from our website or collect from school reception.

Orientation

Each year orientation sessions are offered to the incoming Foundation students. These sessions familiarise the children and their parents with different aspects of school life. There are 6 Drop In sessions for those considering St Joseph's, and 3 Transition sessions for the 2018 class. Everyone is encouraged and welcome to attend.

Ham and pineapple pizza muffins

Pizzas made on muffins are a lifesaver for busy mums! These ham and pineapple pizza muffins are delicious and can even be popped cold into lunch boxes.

Ingredients

- 3 English muffins (split)
- 6 tbs pizza sauce
- 4 slices ham (deli) (diced)
- 1 tin crushed pineapple (well drained)
- 3 cups pizza cheese

Method

- Toast the muffins in the toaster and spread 1 tablespoon of pizza sauce on each.
- 2. Scatter ham and pineapple on the pizza sauce.
- 3. Top with pizza cheese.
- 4. Place under the grill until the cheese is melted and serve.

You can do these in the oven for 10 minutes at 160C fan-forced to melt the cheese, too. I prefer to get these made fast under the grill. Consider making a double batch of these and popping some into lunchboxes cold. They get eaten fast in my house.
