I know the school is in capable hands and we ask God to bless all our families, and staff as you journey together in the next chapter of the school community of St. Josephs'.

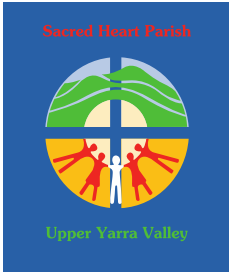

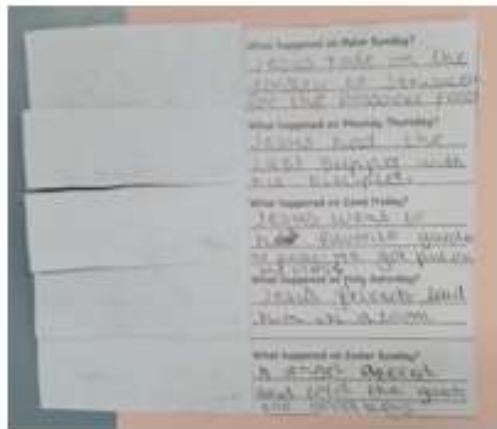
